About the role:

Upswing is looking for a skilled Stage Manager to support our mid-scale circus production *Showdown* for a UK venue tour April-July 2025.

Type of Contract: Freelance

Engagement dates: April - July 2025

Fee: £700 weekly rate

Role is paid at a weekly rate even on weeks that only have 2-3 days work Per diem, travel and accommodation will be covered by the Company

April 2025

Rehearsals in London over two weeks w/c 31st March & 21 April

May-July 2025

UK Tour between 2-7 Performances each week

Tour Locations include London, Manchester, Norwich, Worthing, Gloucester and Kent.

Key Responsibilities:

The Stage Manager will primarily manage the performing company and call the show.

They will:

- Be the main point of contact for the performers, managing the cast and crew on a dayto-day basis
- Coordinate closely with the Producer, Production Manager, TSM and the Creative Team
- Manage the smooth running of rehearsal and sharing periods
- Act as liaison to facilitate excellent communication between creatives, producers, production, technical and cast
- Manage the production petty cash pot
- Take a lead in costume/prop sourcing and buying
- Ensure the setting and maintenance of any props/costume/materials
- Act as onsite liaison for touring venues
- Deputise for other stage management roles in the event of absence
- Coordinate press calls for cast
- Call the show
- Run the tech for the show

- Create and manage the prompt book
- Support understudy/show cover rehearsals
- Send rehearsal reports to all creative team members
- Send daily show reports to all creative team members
- Take responsibility for the health and safety of self and all others involved in the project and ensure all Upswing policies and procedures are appropriately implemented
- Look after the pastoral needs of the company of seven performers
- Treat people with respect and maintain good working relationships
- Maintain high standards under pressure and carry out tasks without detailed supervision
- Ensure a commitment to Equality, Diversity and Inclusion in all activities

About you:

We are looking for someone who:

- Has professional Stage Management experience in live performance
- Is confident in supporting production management including sourcing of materials and props
- Has experience of working in devised productions, tracking script developments in rehearsal
- Has excellent people management and communication skills
- Has the ability to work and keep calm under pressure
- Has a proven commitment to ensuring equality, diversity and inclusion

Desirable skills:

- Experience of working in circus is a plus but not an absolute requirement
- Driving license

About the show:

Framed as a good night out, Showdown is a playful exploration of power, competition, and the limits of shared experience.

The show can best be described as a mash up of a talent show, a beauty pageant and the Hunger Games. Five hopeful acrobats compete to be crowned the 'New Face of Circus' and the audience is invited to choose the winner, guided by a charismatic but slightly controlling presenter. The audience is taken on a journey through the highs and lows of competition, questioning concepts like fairness and meritocracy and the idea that the 'best' candidate will always win through.
